Storm Ciara

As you are aware, Storm Ciara damaged a section of the roof on the science tower. Following advice from the Fire Brigade, I had no option but to close the academy for the following 2 days. Our estate team worked exceptionally hard to ensure the academy was open to over half the students within 48 hours and open to all students the following day. Work is already on-going to replace the damage and return our science team to a refurbished and enhanced tower as soon as possible. No other subjects are affected. I would like to thank parents for their understanding and I apologise for any inconvenience caused.

Further site investment

Storm Ciara aside, investment in our site has continued; over £50,000 spent since Christmas on new windows in a number of areas including girls PE changing rooms. February half-term has been busy with the estates team installing new carpets and refurbishment to a numbers of rooms. We are planning additional, significant site investment over the next 12 months.

Internal review

On 3 & 4 February we had a planned internal inspection led by myself, an experienced OFSTED lead inspector and representatives of our academy trust. I am pleased to report many positive findings from the 2 day inspection. I hope this demonstrates to parents our commitment to continuously improving the learning experience of the students.

Term-Time Holidays

Like other secondary schools, Beacon is obliged to fine parents £60 for taking holidays during term-time. Beacon does not receive the £60 and we fully understand the financial reasons for term-time holidays. However, as with all other academies we are expected to impose the fine and code the holiday as 'unauthorised'. Department for Education research identifies a clear link between poor school attendance (under 95%) with poor GCSE results.
