

Dear Parent/Carer

I hope you are all keeping well in these unprecedented times.

Covid – 19

The Secretary of State for education has announced the end to bubble closures and there is now a requirement for x2 Lateral Flow Tests at the start of next term. I will provide full details in due course.

I am very aware that our Y9 'A' band bubble has been disproportionally affected compared with the rest of the academy. I have spoken to many parents when collecting their students following a burst bubble and I share the frustrations caused by the pandemic. With one exception, all other bubbles have either never closed or only closed on one occasion. I am sure parents have seen in the local media the significant impact of the pandemic on schools in our region and the number of children within North East Lincolnshire isolating from schools.

Covid Catch-Up

All Year 9 students have been allocated to their 1st choice option subjects. Option subjects are running with classes as low as 3 students. Overall option class sizes are smaller than average and will enable catch-up during Key stage 4.

An additional class has been created in English, maths and science. This means the students will be spread over 5 classes instead of 4. This will enable smaller class sizes (average size 20) in both Year 10 and Year 11 to support catch-up.

In Year 11 an extended academy day until 3:50pm to facilitate a period 6 in English, maths and science will be available for the students.

I hope this provides parents with assurance that despite the significant impact of the pandemic, the academy has still been providing extra-curricular experiences for the students.

Summer 2021 - Site updates

- The brand new £300,000 'Beacon Block' will be completed by mid-August.
- New replacement roofing to the L Block and A Tower will be completed by the end of July.
- Full academy window replacement of all our older windows will be complete by the end of August.
- New suspended ceilings with LED lighting in all of our 'A' Tower classrooms will be ready for 1 September.

These upgrades to our site are part of a significant investment, well in excess of £1 million ready for the students return in September as our site continues to transform. For this reason we have not been able to provide a year 6 summer school, as our site has to be closed during the summer holiday to enable this significant investment.

Staffing Update

We welcome an additional 10 new members of staff who will join the academy team on 1 September, including 8 new teachers.
