# Covid-19

The academy Covid-19 risk assessment remains in place, with the following key adjustments:

- Students are expected to continue to use hand sanitiser on entry.
- To support social distancing, staff teach from a designated area at the front of the class, indicated by a yellow line. Students must not enter this area.
- Enhanced day-time cleaning continues.
- Split break and lunch with separate dining areas.
- Staggered entry/exit at the start and end of the academy day.

On-site testing will return to the academy in January following the Christmas break, information will be sent in a separate letter.

I would like to thank all students, parents and staff for working within these adjustments. At Beacon Academy, we have created a 'business-as-usual' learning experience for our young people. Beacon students have always followed their full normal timetable in their normal specialist teaching areas. 

Beacon Academy was a finalist at last week's 2021 National Schools Awards held at the House of Lords in London. To be shortlisted as one of the final 4 schools in England was a huge achievement of which we can all be very proud. ## Year 6 update

We have been informed by the Local Authority that Beacon Academy will again be heavily oversubscribed for September 2022 entry. The number of 1<sup>st</sup> choice preferences is significantly higher than the number of places at the academy. We have received in excess of 300 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice preferences to date.

#### Site update

This term our students have been enjoying the £1.25 million summer investment in our academy. It was lovely to welcome so many parents to our parents' evenings in our newly refurbished £300,000 Beacon Block, which created five state-of-the-art classrooms, toilets, new windows and a replacement roof.

Our newly upgraded £100,000 sports hall complete with new roof, flooring and re-decoration provides a fantastic facility for our students.

Roof, ceiling and lighting replacements throughout our 'Inspire' Tower and 'L' block have taken our learning environments to the next level.

## **Extra-Curricular**

It has been a real pleasure to see so many extra-curricular clubs and activities take place this term with Eco and 3D Printing Club proving very popular. Last Thursday, a fantastic Christmas performance of 'Aladdin and the Magic Bucket' played to an audience of very proud parents.

Our student sports leaders were again selected to organize the 'Panathon' sporting event for both primary and secondary schools. The PE team have organized and delivered a significant number of clubs, trips and fixtures this term in a wide range of sports which have included specialist coaching.

I would like to congratulate the Year 9 boys' football team who have progressed to the semi-final of the North East Lincolnshire cup competition. The team will play Healing Science Academy in the new-year for a place in the final at Blundell Park.
